Addressing the issue of rainwater and snowmelt drainage fees under the new legal regulations is an important matter for all companies that operate in water and sewage system industry. It needs to be stressed that changing the definition of sewage, where rainwater and snowmelt are not defined as sewage, and introducing a new system of fees for services connected with water, have changed the legal situation of many companies in sewage industry whether they have already charged fees for such services or not.

The enforcement of the new Water Law and the amendment of the act on collective water supply and sewage removal does not mean that this kind of water will not interest companies operating in water and sewage systems industry.

The presentation will point out the issue of regulating rainwater after the enforcement of the Water Law Act and the actions to be undertaken in this area by "Polish Waterworks" Chamber of Commerce.
